

Mobile Tower Erection Course

The Mobile Tower Erection Course is designed to train delegates in the safe assembly, use and dismantling of mobile access towers. It introduces them to the equipment in a way that is thorough yet easily understood and explains the major constituent parts of the equipment and the tower uses. The course includes sections on the stability of the tower and the causes of instability along with the correct method of inspection prior to the towers use.

The syllabus includes:

- Introduction to mobile access towers
- Tower assembly
- Stability
- Safe use of towers
- Repositioning of towers
- Tower inspection
- Care and maintenance
- Tower dismantling
- Regulations and standards

Delegates who successfully complete this course will receive:

- Certification valid for 3 years

Duration:

1 day (8 hours)

Maximum Delegates:

12 maximum

Criteria required for training to commence:

- Classroom for theory with table chairs and an electrical socket.
- Appropriate scaffold tower in sound condition with instruction manual.
- A safe training area large enough for the tower to be manoeuvred and high enough to attain the equipment's full assembly.
- Delegates must have appropriate PPE (Gloves, Safety Footwear).
